Kapiti Coast District Council Control of Alcohol in Public Places Bylaw 2018

Thank you for taking part in the Control of Alcohol in Public Places Bylaw review. Overall, our Councillors were pleased with the review process, and appreciated the contribution from the Kāpiti Coast Older Persons' Council.

On 6 December 2018, the Councillors unanimously voted to:

- Repeal the Kapiti Coast District Council Control of Alcohol in Public Places Bylaw 2013; and
- Adopt the Kapiti Coast District Council Control of Alcohol in Public Places Bylaw 2018.

Council has noted the request to take a more active role in reducing alcohol harm by:

- Developing a Local Alcohol Policy (LAP) to limit the sale and supply of alcohol;
- Advocating for better legislation and improved social services; and
- Distributing ALAC resources across the District.

The 2018-2021 Kāpiti Coast District Council Policy Work Programme (PWP) is scheduled to go to Council in early 2019 for adoption. Presently, the development of a LAP is included in the draft PWP. In addition, Council's Research and Policy team and Programme Design and Delivery team will continue to advocate for better legislation and improved social services.

The Programme Design and Delivery team has ordered the ALAC booklet for older people, and will work with the Older Persons' Council in the New Year to discuss how the booklet might be distributed across the Kāpiti District.
